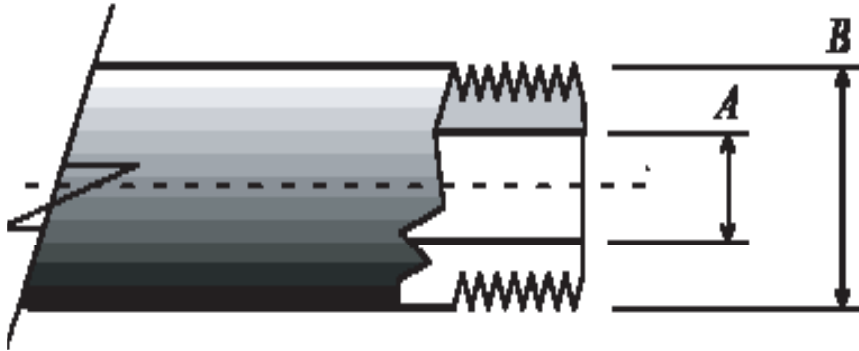


TEMPERATURE SENDER SIZES



The industry designation for National Pipe Threads comes from the pipe's inside diameter (*A*). If you measure the outside diameter (*B*) of both the pipe or an actual sender with the same designation, it will be considerably larger than the NPT size.

NPT Designation	Inside Diameter (<i>A</i>)	Outside Diameter (<i>B</i>)	Outside Diameter (Fraction)
1/8-27	1/8 in.	0.40 in.	13/32 in.
1/4-18	1/4 in.	0.50 in.	35/64 in.
3/8-18	3/8 in.	0.675 in.	43/64 in.
1/2-14	1/2 in.	0.84 in.	27/32 in.
